without brandline _____

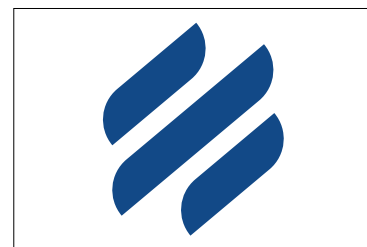


Logo is one integral unified element.

- !! Disproportionate logo stretching is inadmissible.
- !! Proportionate or disproportionate separate stretching of either symbol or sign is inadmissible.
- !! Use of other font for the brandline is inadmissible.



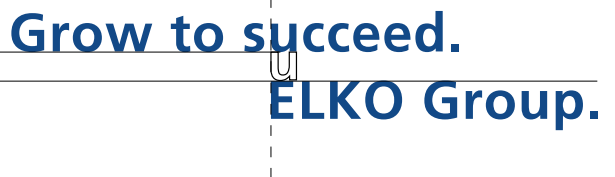
In specific cases it is possible to use the symbol as a graphical design element.



It is possible to use the brandline separately from the logo, but logo and brandline should have proportional sizes.

If using brandline separately from logo it is possible to divide it in two parts and to write it in two lines.

The second line is aligned by the left margin of the "u" letter in the first line. Line spacing – "u" letter height.

!! Logo usage with many-colored background, other color background is inadmissible (except for black).



In specific cases upon agreement with HQ it is possible to use inverse on other color backgrounds
